

## APPENDIX A

**Goal 1: Provide essential public services to improve quality of life for individuals and families with low-moderate incomes, including special needs populations and those experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless.**

- Grow an environment that supports health and wellness among community members. (including, access to health services, centralized resources for homeless in a one-stop shop, access to quality and nutritious food, expand navigation services to persons that at-risk of becoming homeless)
- Expand gap funding for flexible low barrier grants to support emergency needs in coordination with current community initiatives. (including utility and security deposit)
- Grow individual education outcomes. (English language learning, early childhood, peer to peer education, job skills)
- Encourage agencies to coordinate services for persons experiencing homelessness.
- Address barriers to safe, decent, affordable housing. (tenant education, landlord meetings)
- Support distribution of materials on affordable housing and fair housing at conferences, workshops, and other public venues.
