

BBQ Rules, Regulations & Responsibilities

For all Lewiston Parks



GAS GRILLS ONLY. CHARCOAL GRILLS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Per the Lewiston Fire Department.

A BBQ is allowed contingent upon Lewiston Fire Department approval, especially during periods of possible burning bans. The Fire Prevention Division should be contacted the day of the BBQ: Weekdays (207) 513-3002, Ext. 3605; Weekends (207) 513-3002, Ext. 3606 for the on-duty Captain.

- BBQ area will be open daily from 9:00 AM to sunset.
- Users must bring their own gas grills and a functioning general household fire extinguisher – charcoal grills are not permitted.
- BBQ grill must not be left unattended.
- Users must **carry in/carry out** their materials and goods and shall be responsible for carrying out all their waste; bring trash bags with you.
- Discharging of wastes, including soaps and detergents, is prohibited.
- Utilized area is to be left clean after use.
- Activities that endanger people or property are prohibited.
- Disorderly conduct and intoxicating beverages are prohibited.
- Grill must be **(25' away)** from playground, wood chips, basketball hoop/court, pool, or skate park.
- If a BBQ gathering consists of **more than 25 people**, contact Administration (207) 513-3121; Lewiston Police (207) 784-6421 (Lewiston, Auburn, Poland communications system) to provide the organizer's contact information and Fire Department at the number provided above.
